

## Provincial Government


- *PDP proposes, inter alia “a more serious drive to transform and develop rural areas...”*


- Migration from Rural to Urban areas and specifically the Metros

- Increasing Urban population growth









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
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






# The Development Framework – Land Capability Index and Commodity Potential



# The Development Framework – Land Capability Index and Livestock Potential




# The 1<sup>st</sup> Draft Rural Development Plan – The approach



<b>Tourism</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Fly-fishing</li><li>• Special events (i.e. Passion Play)</li><li>• Sports tourism</li><li>• Adventure sports (4X4, mountain biking)</li><li>• Ski resort</li><li>• Rhodes Airfield</li><li>• Transport infrastructure upgrade.</li></ul>
<b>Renewable Energy</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Solar PV opportunities</li><li>• Provision of downstream services (security, fencing, maintenance, logistics)</li></ul>
