

The cropping program in the Eastern Cape is implemented using three approaches, and the beneficiaries select the approach that is favourable to their condition/s



to farmers and farmers buy their own



2. Provision of production inputs:


DRDAR provides production inputs and farmers contribute with mechanisation services

### 3. Implementing with partners:


Partners for all commodities are selected through an open process where farmers and industry partner engage voluntarily and the partner apply to be in DRDAR Database of partners

Beneficiaries are selected through a rigorous and transparent process in order to ensure that the process is fair and selects deserving farmers



- **Involvement of youth and women**















- The applicant must have short to long term legitimate right to use the land is applying on

- The entity must have a turnover of more than

- In rural communities, farmers are encouraged to apply as an association/commodity group

















- Vegetable and Lucerne farmers must be irrigating for production





- Secure market for produce






The Cropping programme is implemented across the Province based on the resource of each district Grain production is taking place in five districts of the province, with the exception of Sarah Baartman
